However it is not clearly stated in schedule the intervals the work will be done, is it all at once, quarterly, monthly, semi-annually to be able to calculate the mobilization and demobilization cost of equipment and personnel.</p> <p>Kindly advise.</p>	<p>The scope of work shall be executed on need-basis. The quantities in the tender are spread over the 2-year period.</p> <p>The first batch of work will be executed upon Contract signing and the rest of the works will be requested from time to time depending on drilling needs. This is estimated to be on quarterly basis. However, some services such as inspection of BHA may be requested every 2 months, or as drilling operations dictate.</p> <p>For every call, the scope of works will be clearly communicated to the successful bidder in good time.</p> <p>The mobilization and demobilization costs are covered within the provided calls as explained in the next row (No. 2) of this table.</p>

The successful bidder may break for some time and resume later when called on.</p> <p>For any call, the successful bidder will charge for the cost of mobilization and demobilization. There is therefore no error in the estimated quantities.</p> <p>Please note that estimated call quantities are the minimum number of calls in the two-year period.</p>
3	<p>Invitation to Tender Page 2, Tender Document.</p> <p>Tender Closing Date</p> <p>According to Addendum No.1, you have stated that the closing date for this tender is <b>25th October 2022 at 10.00 a.m.</b> However, we request a two- week extension to enable us have the clarifications sent in on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2022 to be addressed and to compile/provide all the required documentation to have a compliant tender.</p> <p>Kindly advise on this.</p>	<p>An additional one-week extension up to <b>1<sup>st</sup> November 2022 at 10.00 a.m.</b> has been granted as per <b>Addendum No.2 uploaded on the website.</b> This is sufficient to compile the bid and provide required documentation.</p>
