1	Page 172: Payment - Payment Terms and Conditions	Please clarify, If we are as leader to make consortium with one Kenya local company, is it acceptable by KenGen that all payment is paid to the leader's account in US dollar as the leader will offer financial facility to both parties to implement this project?	Yes. Payments will be done to the consortium leader's account in the bidder's currency of the quotation. Payment Terms Must be demonstrated in the Joint Venture Agreement/ consortium agreements on who the payment will be made.
2		Formation of joint ventures or consortiums for this tender is not clear as was in the earlier tender.	Firms and entities are encouraged to collaborate. Those that jointly participate should submit proposed consortium agreements between the parties, with the roles of each party clearly defined. (Not more than one consortium agreement of the same firms will be accepted)
3		Can we submit bid bonds from insurance companies	No, as per the tender requirement; Tender security should be from any reputable banks registered by the Central Bank of Kenya. International bidders, should have tender security through

			local corresponding banks registered by the Central Bank of Kenya.
4		We have noticed a lot of material misgovernance, where some equipment (technology) are obsolete yet you want to mix with modern technology. Kindly clarify if we are free to offer a different design which does not deviate from your specification.	<p>Note the following:</p> <p><i>Specifications (minimum basic requirements)</i> – This is the generally accepted technical specifications of the item and forms the basis for quotation/bidding comparison.</p> <p><i>Bidder confirming specifications</i> – The bidder is expected to give the technical specifications of their item they will supply explaining how and why their item is same or better than the minimum requirements given by KenGen.</p> <p>The tenderer is to provide the sizes and qualities based on their design, which should be same or better than, here, specified by KenGen.</p> <p>However, quote for the rates and maintain the requested quantities.</p>
