## CLARIFICATION NO. I

In accordance with the 'Tender for Supply of Uniforms, Protective Clothing and Footwear (Re-Tender)', KenGen hereby issues **Clarification No. I** as follows:

1	Further to the above referenced tender SCHEDULE 2 PROTECTIVE FOOTWEAR, items and quantities in the PRICE SCHEDULE FORMS and SECTION V - SCHEDULE OF REQUIREMENTS are different	Please refer to <i>Addendum 1</i> .
2	Most of the fabrics required are of a specialized nature and not available locally. A lot of communication with the manufacturers regarding availability, authenticity by way of test certificates will be required and this clearly cannot be done in the short period provided	Samples shall not be submitted with the tenders, please refer to STAGE 2: TECHNICAL EVALUATION CRITERIA (TR 2) of the tender document, on samples.
3	While the tender is clearly indicated that the client shall require pre-production samples. It is silent on presentation of tender samples during bid submission. In the event that tender samples shall be required as is most likely the case, they need to be made and shipped	
4	We also notice there are several items appearing on the schedule of requirement but missing on the price schedule. a) All footwear save for safety boots. Even for the safety boots the price schedule indicates a quantity of 1256 pairs while the schedule of requirements indicate 2020 pairs. b) The document has two schedules of special requirement that shows differing items and quantities. c) On garment requirement, a lot of items on the schedule of requirement are missing from the price list e.g. White and Grey Dust Coats, Windbreaker, Great Coat, Sweaters. 5	<p>In addition, we would like to enquire about the sample requirements for two items: <i>No. 1. Full Grey Ordinary Overall and No. 2. White/Grey Dustcoats Ordinary</i>, which require a specialized fabric (98% cotton 2% Carbon)</p> <p>Due to the specialized nature of the fabric required for these items, we would like to request for an allowance for bidders to submit samples that meet the fabric specifications but may deviate from the required color or shade. However, if awarded these items on the tender, a pre-production sample with the exact and correct color and shade shall be submitted for approval before commencing bulk production.</p> <p>Secondly, we would like to humbly request for an extension on the tender submission date by at least 21 days to allow the arrival of the sample fabrics we have imported to be used for the samples production.</p>	<p>Please refer to STAGE 2: TECHNICAL EVALUATION CRITERIA (TR 2) of the tender document, on samples.</p> <p>Tender is extended by 1 week as per <i>Addendum 1</i>.</p>
