In addition, the Consultant will submit via a NEMA portal an electronic version of the ESIA Reports. The Consultant will follow up on the licensing process and follow through to the end when NEMA issues the license or makes the final decision.</p> <p>PROPOSED BY THE CONSULTANT: We propose that the Consultant’s responsibility be terminated once KenGen has reviewed and accepted the ESIA Reports and the Consultant has submitted the required 12 hard copies and a soft copy with electronic version of the ESIA Reports. KenGen would follow up on the licensing process through to the end when NEMA issues the license or makes the final decision. This request is made since the Consultant has no control over the extent of time it takes for NEMA to review, process and make the final decision on the issuing of the NEMA license.</p>	<p>The requirements of RFP are sufficient.</p> <p>The Consultant shall upload via NEMA portal an electronic version of the final ESIA report and submit to NEMA twelve (12) hard copies of the final ESIA reports (out of which two of the hard copies after stamping by NEMA will be returned to the Client) and a soft copy in USB flash drive. The Consultant will furnish the Client with NEMA acknowledgement slip following submission of the reports.
